

3. To gives the information of preparation of organic manure and demonstration arranged on earthworm manure production and it is given by Kondvilkar teachers, Palgad.
4. Due to parasitic Cuscuta (Amervel) the yield of farmers decreases so far, one lecture and demonstration given by Prof. Mane, Balasaheb Sawnt Konkan Agriculture University, Dapoli on management of parasitic Cuscuta. In future, University will be arrange four demo practicals in Lokarvan village and also other nearby village of Lokarvan with the Help of Mandangad Arts, Commerce and Science college, Mandangad.
5. Mumbai University accepted the paper of Dr. Sawnt S.A. on KVS and it is included in curriculum of Extension department.




